I was dispatched to a cornfield east of Arlington Rd on Mason Rd for a property damage complaint. Upon arrival, I made contact with the caller, Steven Deehr, who advised while he was trying to enter his field the low cable line struck the grain extension on his John Deere combine causing damage. Steven advised there was a car accident that involved the telephone pole earlier in the summer. Steven also added after the new pole was put into place, the cable company never fixed the low hanging line.

I observed Steven's combine which the grain extension was bent on the top of the combine with some welds broke on the corner of it. Pictures were taken with my department issued body camera. Pictures were also taken of the low hanging line. Steven was issued a department business card with the report number. Steven stated he would be contacting the cable company with a claim for the damage. Dispatch was advised to contact Omni Fiber in regards to the low hanging line to make proper repairs.
